It's that time of the year again - the IUAA Maynooth Road Relays are taking place on Saturday, 12th November on the spectacular grounds of St. Patrick's College, Maynooth, South Campus.

One lap of the course is a distance of one mile. Each ladies team consists of four members, each men's team consists of five members and you can enter as many teams from your college as you wish.

Men's Race: Will start at 2.15pm sharp
Laps: 1 - 2 - 3 - 2 - 1

Tickets: €7.50 per head.

Meal Ticket Deadline: **10.00pm Tuesday 8th November. Payment deadline 5pm, Thursday 10th November.**

Captains are reminded of the following:

All entries must be made online by the deadline. No late entries will be accepted. No faxed, emailed or telephoned entries will be accepted. No new entries on the day will be accepted. Captains are strongly advised to enter reserve teams and substitute athletes.

Meal Tickets: All meal tickets must be ordered online and paid for by the deadline, as NUI-Maynooth Athletics Club has to give numbers to the catering department. No money will be handled on the day. Payment for all meal tickets ordered must be received by NUIM AC by 5pm, Thursday, 10th November. Meals will only be available to people with pre-paid tickets. Cheques should be made payable to 'NUI-Maynooth A.C.' Post cheques to 'Paul Davis, Athletics Club, Sports Office, NUI-Maynooth, Maynooth, Co. Kildare'. Meal tickets will be given to your club captain in a pre-sealed envelope at registration.

Athletes must be eligible for IUAA competition as defined in 6.2.1 & 8.2 of the IUAA constitution.

Check-in opens at 12.00noon and closes 20 minutes prior to the start of each race, so as to allow the races to start on time. All athletes are encouraged to check-in early so as to avoid a last minute rush.
