IUAA Track & Field Championships Friday 29th and Saturday 30th April 2011 Queens University Belfast – Antrim Forum

The IUAA Track & Field Championships are taking place on Friday 29th and Saturday 30th April 2011 in the Antrim Forum, hosted by the Queens University Belfast.

This year the IUAA is continuing to incorporate a Tier 2 championships into the main championships to provide an additional championship for smaller colleges. The results of the main championship will be re-scored to enable the winners of the Tier 2 trophy to be calculated. All athletes are asked to bring their student cards with them, as all athletes will be asked to confirm their registration details over the course of the weekend. **Please ensure that all athletes familiarise themselves with the timetable.**

Meal Ticket Deadline: 10.00pm Tuesday 26th April. **Payment deadline Friday 29th** April at check-in.

Intersarsity Dinner and Presentation: 7.00pm Whitla Hall, on the Queens Campus.

Tickets: £32.50 or €35.00 (Includes Meal/Band/Disco/Late Bar).

Captains are reminded of the following:

All entries must be made online by the deadline. No late entries will be accepted. No new entries on the day will be accepted. Captains are strongly advised to enter complete teams and substitute athletes.

Meal Tickets: All meal tickets must be ordered online and paid for by the deadline, as Queens University Belfast Athletic Club has to give numbers to the venue. Payment for meal tickets is required on Friday the 29th April at the latest when captains check in their athletes. Captains will receive their meal tickets in exchange of the payment. Only cheques are accepted and should be made payable to 'Queens University Athletics Club'. Cheques can also be posted to 3 Barban Hill Terrace, Dromore, County Down, Northern Ireland, BT25 1TN.

Athletes must be eligible for IUAA competition as defined in 6.2.1 & 8.2 of the IUAA constitution.

One Year Down (OYD) athletes can only compete in the season immediately following the academic year in which they were last held a valid student card. Athletes can't compete as a OYD during a year off books.

Check-in closes 1 hour prior to the start of each event, so as to allow starting orders to be drawn and substitutions to be made. All athletes are encouraged to check-in early so as to avoid a last minute rush.
